- According to a National Safety Council study from 2011, 54.5 per cent of eye injuries are caused by chemical burns.
- ▶ From 2005 to 2014, the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB) recorded 16,207 chemical-related lost-time injuries (LTIs) from exposure to caustic, noxious or allergenic substances.
- Chemical burns account for only a fraction of the reported cutaneous and ocular injuries however they are responsible for nearly 30 per cent of all burn-related deaths.
